













The Standard Response Protocol: *Scenario Exercise*

1	An unknown male was seen walking in the hallways and can't be immediately located.					
2	The local police department is reporting a teenage male ran from a traffic stop about two blocks from the school. It is lunch time during the first week of school.					
3	There is the report of a chemical spill approximately ½ mile from the school as the result of a roll over traffic accident. It is a nice day with multiple students outside during lunch period.					
4	A large apartment fire is reported to be burning in the townhomes across the street from the school. Police report an arsonist may have started the fire.					
5	You have a staff member collapse in the middle of the hallway approximately one minute before the next passing period bell rings.					
6	Deans receive reports of two students flashing a gun at a nearby park approximately 10 minutes ago. The students were seen earlier in the building, but now their location is unknown.					
7	A water line ruptured and is now flooding the building in multiple classrooms and into the hallway.					
8	It is about five minutes before release time, and severe weather is moving into the area. There is severe lightning, heavy rain, and hail. There are multiple parents lined up outside to pick-up their kids.					
9	Police report they are actively looking for two armed suspects in the area of a carjacking. You have two buses full of kids, pulling into the parking lot returning from a field trip as you receive this news.					
10	A neighbor calls the school and reports that a vicious pit bull just attacked his dog while walking on the sidewalk adjacent to the school. There are three PE classes outside in the area.					
11	A teacher reports a student quietly reported to her that another student in her classroom was bragging about having a gun in his backpack. It is about three minutes before the passing period.					
12	Anonymous tip line receives multiple tips that a known expelled student recently posted a video of him holding a gun in a car outside the school. It is about five minutes before the release of the school day.

13	Two groups of students are reported to be meeting to fight in a bathroom on campus at 11:30. There are a number of kids in the halls and common areas at this time because of the lunch periods.					
14	A student recently suspended for making threats to shoot up the school is seen by a teacher walking through the parking lot of the school.					
15	A parent visitor checks in at the security desk, but becomes hostile and aggressive. He demands to see the principal and storms through the door without authorization.					
16	The science room reports there was a chemical accident in their room and multiple students were injured or affected by the small explosion. There is a terrible chemical smell in the area.					
17	A parent reports her son left home after an argument and may be enroute to the school armed with a handgun. The student was last seen at a gas station about 5 blocks from school 10 minutes ago.					
18	A student is reported to be very sick and unconscious in the bathroom. Passing period just occurred and an ambulance has been called.					
19	A student in crisis is reported to be suicidal. She is outside in the quad threatening to harm herself if anyone comes near her.					
20	A student reports their teacher stated they are not in a “good place” and “can’t go on anymore.” The teacher began crying and walked out of the classroom. Their current location is unknown.					
21	You observe two students in the cafeteria during lunch hour suspected to be heavily intoxicated or under the influence of alcohol or drugs.					
22	You learn of a “tornado warning” for all of Douglas County. It is during an after-school event with more than 100 people in your building.					
23	An area business reports just having an armed robbery occur in their parking lot. The description of the suspects are two teenage males running towards campus. It is during morning entry.					
24	You observe an unknown male and female arguing in the parking lot. The argument is very heated, and the female is shouting for someone to help her. They do not appear to be students or staff.					
25	A grass fire in the area has now moved within approximately ½ mile of your building. There are heavy winds blowing toward the school and dry conditions all around the area.
